

ZNU INTERDISCIPLINARY WORKSHOP PROGRAM

«PEACE IN TIMES OF WAR: LANDSCAPES OF PEACE UNDER CONDITIONS OF FORCED MOBILITY»

The program, developed and implemented by Zaporizhzhia National University researchers, and hosted by Bielefeld University, taking place from June 17th to July 14th, is a comprehensive academic and field-based initiative addressing the multi-layered intersections of ongoing conflict, forced migration, and the co-creation of peace. Through a series of academic workshops, institutional coordination, and empirical field studies, the initiative explores interdisciplinary approaches to everyday peace practices, the socio-acoustic landscapes of war, the paradoxes of coexistence, and the role of academic and cultural mobility in peacemaking. The program concludes with on-site investigations into the history of borders and institutional reflections aimed at conceptualizing key findings to inform future research and policy actions within the scope of peace and mobilities.
